1. Call to Order:

2. Approval of previous minutes:

Tony Merkel motioned to accept the previous meeting minutes of February 20, 2023, seconded by David Thiel and all present agreed.

3. Email approvals:

- The treasurer reported that the financials are in current good standing.

5. Committee Reports

a) ACA Reports

- The ACA submitted the following report:

Lot 7 : Remodel / Additions – Roof line will change slightly, deck addition. Needs story poles & neighborhood review.

Lot 16 : Under construction.

Lot 22 : Under construction.

Lot 25 : Sauna installation has been approved but has not been installed yet.

Lot 29 : Walls and roof have been completed, siding and door frames next.

Lot 49 : Awning not complete.

Lot 50 : Shed installation – still awaiting formal request / application.

b) Water Operator

- No concerns noted, all systems running.

6. Old Business

a) SB100 policies signed:

KSM had printer issues and was not able to bring the previously approved policies to the meeting for signing. KSM will send the policies to the President for digital signature and then upload the policies on the web page.

b) Open / Bonfires:

The Board has agreed with the concerns received from owners that open fires are a danger / fire risk to the community. As this change would need to be made to the covenants, the Board will look at ALL suggested / needed changes to the covenants, to minimize the costs involved. Open fires will not be allowed during the summer months.

7. New Business

a) Board positions elections:

The Board welcomed the new members, Angela Shetzer and Elize Boyd. Two board members had been elected, as Lea Tyler resigned from the Board 03/08/23. After a brief discussion, the following positions and tenures were agreed to unanimously:

b) Open Space Committee (OSC) board liaison:

Elise Boyd will be the OSC board liaison.

c) Absolute water rights:

The associations absolute rights need to be completed and filed by September 23, 2023. Patty Heydenberk has made contact with the HOA's water attorney. The board agreed to costs of up to \$15,000.00 to ensure the confirmation of the absolute rights. A Zoom call will be scheduled with the attorney and all board members to discuss the requirements and all particulars needed to file.

d) Amendment to governing documents:

There are several possible changes that will need to be made to the governing documents, including open fire ban during summer and multiple changes to the ACA guidelines as well as adjusted / clearer verbiage changes on certain points. The board will work on compiling a list of all the changes.
